# Agenda Item 1.0 Resolution 03-2022 Authorizing CRW to pursue Grant Funding for an Emergency Power Study

Mr. Bjornstedt explained that staff has explored opportunities for alternative funding through FEMA grants for some capital projects and a study. Staff is asking the Board to approve staff to pursue grant funding for an emergency power study since this was not already included in the BN 21-23 budget. The grant funding would be a matching funds grant (25% CRW to 75% from FEMA).

Commissioner French asked about some of the options of power the study would explore and if solar was an option for pump stations and it is not based on the amount of power required for those facilities. Commissioner Angier asked if there is a dedicated list within the CIP list and there are not specific projected identified as grant projects but there is flexibility. Commissioner Garrison asked about the

percentage split between CRW and FEMA and asked if the staff administrative time can be included in the grant funding total.
