To earn this recognition, budget documents must excel as policy documents, financial plan, operations guide, and communications tool. Since CRW prepares a biennial budget, this award is valid for two years.

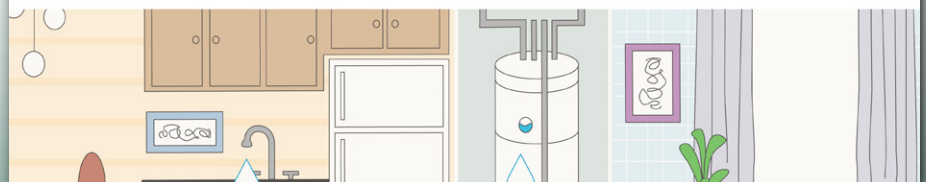
MARCH 18-24 IS 'FIX A LEAK WEEK'

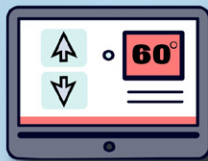

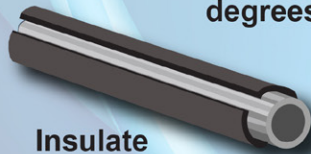
By using these tips you can keep the water flowing consistently in your home.
