Regulatory

All 73 samples collected and analyzed for the December monitoring period showed no presence of coliform/*E. coli* bacteria.

Non-Regulatory

General water quality parameters (pH, temperature, chlorine, TDS, hardness, alkalinity) were collected throughout the distribution system at 19 locations in the North and South systems.

Monthly watershed sampling was conducted at 4 long-term sampling locations for total organic carbon, VOCs (Volatile Organic Chemicals), nutrients (nitrate/nitrite, total phosphorus, orthophosphate, etc), coliform density, pH, dissolved oxygen, TDS, and temperature.

Raw water at our intakes and finished water was tested for giardia and cryptosporidium.

- As of January 3rd, the Willamette basin snowpack was 110% of median. Last year in January the snowpack was 148% of median.
- December **precipitation in the Willamette basin was 97% of median.** Precipitation since the beginning of the water year (October 1 January 1) has been 88% of median.
- The April through September streamflow forecasts in the Clackamas River at Estacada is 110% of median.
- The three-month outlook from the NOAA Climate Prediction Center calls for elevated chances of below normal temperatures for Oregon, and only slightly elevated chances of above normal precipitation for northern Oregon.
