Regulatory

All 84 samples collected and analyzed for the March monitoring period showed no presence of coliform/*E. coli* bacteria.

Lead and Copper testing was conducted in the CRW-Clackamas service area. All 60 samples were below the action level.


Non-Regulatory

General water quality parameters (pH, temperature, chlorine, TDS, hardness, alkalinity) were collected for the distribution system at 16 locations in the North and South systems.

Monthly watershed sampling was conducted at 4 long-term sampling locations for total organic carbon, nutrients (nitrate/nitrite, total phosphorus, orthophosphate, etc.), coliform density, pH, dissolved oxygen, TDS, and temperature. Raw water at our intakes was also tested for giardia and cryptosporidium.

- As of April 4, the Willamette basin snowpack was 122% of normal.
- As of March 22, the year-to-date precipitation in the Willamette basin is 97% of average.
- The April through September streamflow forecasts in the basin range from 101% to 103% of average. If conditions remain similar, water supplies in the basin are likely to be near normal this summer.
- The climate outlook for the month of April indicates probabilities favoring below-average temperatures for much of the state, with the exception of the eastern third of the state which shows equal chances of above- or below-average temperatures; probabilities indicate equal chances of above- or below-average precipitation. The seasonal outlook (April through June) indicates below-average precipitation is likely, while the southern third of Oregon is likely to experience above-average temperatures.
